NOTICE OF RACE

Baikal Ice Sailing Week 2018 consists of four events:

1. Organizing authority and venue

Baikal Ice Sailing Week will be organized by Russian National Ice-Sailing Union, in the cooperation with Russian Yachting Federation, Irkutsk Sports Ministry and Irkutsk Sailing Federation. Racing area will be Baikal Lake, Maloe More, Olkhon Region, Irkutsk.

2. Rules

The events will be sailed in compliance with NIA Sailing Rules, IDNIYRA By-Laws, Regulations of Russian Yachting Federation, Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may be modified at the Skippers Meetings and posted on Official Notice Board. If there is a conflict between a rule of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instruction, Sailing Instructions take precedence.

If there is a conflict between Russian and English versions of the NoR or SIs, Russian documents take precedence.

3. Eligibility

All competitors shall be members of their National DN or Ice-Optimist fleets. All DN and Ice-Optimist ice yachts shall meet the requirements of Official Class Specifications. Ice-Optimist must have IODA disc and Optimist Class Insignia on sail.

4. Age limits

DN Men - birth 2004 and older

DN Women - birth 2004 and older

DN Grand Masters – birth 1948 and older

DN Junior – birth year 1997 - 2004

Ice-Optimist – birth year 2002 - 2009

5. Entry and registration

Personal registration is mandatory on 30th March 2018 at the race office according to the schedule in p.7 of this NoR. At registration each participant shall produce the entry form, prove of the insurance, entry fee. Russian participants in addition have to execute Regulations of Russian Yachting Federation according to the entry.

6. Entry fee

Entry fee will be accepted in cash in Russian Rubles during the registration on 30th March 2018.

Ice Optimist – 1500 rubles.

DN – for sailors younger than 18 years old – 3000 rubles.

DN sailors of 18 years old and over– 7000 rubles.

Event schedule, especially starting times, can be changed by Sailing Instructions or Amendments and will be posted on the Official Notice Board at least 2 hours before it takes effect.

8. Sailing instructions

Sailing instructions will be supplied by organizers and available to all participants at the registration. More information during the events will be posted on Official Notice Board and delivered by the race officer or organizers at the Skippers briefings.

9. Race scoring, advertising.

The events will be scored in compliance with NIA Sailing Rules, IDNIYRA By-Laws, Regulations of Russian Yachting Federation, Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. For all events in all classes when from 4 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores. The maximum number of races is 15 for each event.

10. Liability and insurance

The Organizing Authority of the Events and all parties involved in Organizing them do not accept any liability for loss of life and property, personal injury or damage of property. Every competitor is responsible in every respect for the way he or she sails. Each competitor shall produce evidence of valid third party liability insurance of a minimum of 500.000,- EUR coverage.

11. Measurement

Each boat shall be available for the measurement inspection from the first race until the end of events. Measurement and rules compliance inspections may be carried out throughout the regatta before or after each race. If any part of the boat doesn't meet class rules, the measurer has the right to protest the competitor from the race or regatta.

12. Prizes

First sailors in each group of each class will be awarded. Organizers and sponsors can award other and special prizes.
